Types of Sponsor Licenses

The Employment Readiness Scale™ provides three types of Sponsor license configuration to support the analysis of aggregate client data across Agency licenses. Each type of Sponsor license helps identify best practices regarding changes in employment readiness. They differ on the following factors:

- Whether client data can be shared among a group of agencies or whether client data can be shared with only a designated agency (through Client Transfer).
- Whether or not Client Coding variables are consistent across all Agency licenses in the Sponsor group, thus allowing for analysis by Client Coding variables at both the Agency and Sponsor levels.
- Whether Local Programs (interventions) are defined broadly by the Sponsor or specifically by the Agency.

The table below summarizes the similarities and differences among the three Sponsor license types regarding functionality:
